## About real estate

The residence is located in the heart of the old town of Trogir, a small island in Croatia, once a fortress known as the museum city. The 160 sqm apartment has a private 150 sqm rooftop terrace with deckchairs, a lounge area and a 360 ° view whirlpool. Trogir has 2,300 years of continuous urban tradition. Since 1997, the historic center of Trogir has been listed on the UNESCO World Heritage. Thanks to its impressive medieval architecture, the old town of Trogir attracts people interested in culture, art and history. The streets are reminiscent of the Middle Ages.

The port of Trogir and its marina provide accommodation for boats up to 50 meters long. The harbor area includes everything you need for your comfort and convenience, with port assistance, dry docks and a wide range of maritime and customer services. Thanks to this, Trogir is undoubtedly one of the most popular destinations for cruising on the Adriatic and an irresistible part of tourism.

Despite the most, you can reach the island of Čiovo, which offers the best summer activities on the beautiful beaches and its waters. Some of the shores are full of cafés and restaurants, equipment for water sports and diving. Occasionally, some of the beaches are almost deserted, providing plenty of privacy.

On the two small nearby islands of Drvenik Veliki and Drvenik Mali, which are easily accessible by boat, you can enjoy quiet sandy beaches and restaurants where you can enjoy typical Dalmatian cuisine.
